Below are the top 10 recruiting sites in the CIPHER study.

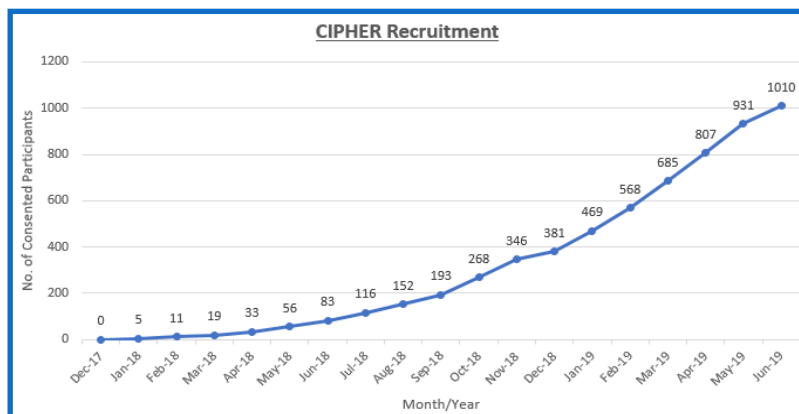

**GREEN:** Activated sites (total: **72**)

**YELLOW:** SIV done, waiting to be activated (total: **3**)

**BLUE:** SIV booked (total: **2**)

### CONSENTING PARTICIPANTS

**Whenever possible, patients should be consented prospectively!**

We want to avoid consenting too many patients retrospectively because we cannot collect the baseline questionnaires for these participants. The baseline questionnaires must be collected prior to surgery to ensure this reflects the participant's pre-operative state. Retrospective consent was introduced to include patients where a decision to form a stoma is not made until the patient is in surgery.

**ANTERIOR RESECTIONS:** If the patient is having an anterior resection +/- loop ileostomy, we would encourage you to consent these patient prospectively. This is because we know that in 80% of cases, these patients will have a stoma formed. If the patient does not have a stoma formed, they must be withdrawn from the study.
