Timeline of Scholarship Process

- Submit application online by 6 May 2014
- Applications processed and sent to donors. Only the scholarship application form is sent to donors – they do not have access to your transcript or CV
- Donors make decisions throughout summer. Some may contact shortlisted applicants for further information
- All applicants informed of decision on each scholarship as and when it is made
- Successful applicants need to return acceptance form by a set date

Bursaries

- Awarded to applicants with outstanding academic background
- No need to apply for a bursary – applicants are selected to receive bursaries at the time their application is reviewed by the admissions panel, or later in the process
- Bursaries normally do not exceed more than 20% of the tuition fees
- Deducted from the second instalment of tuition fees, due in January
