

Apprenticeship Students: Assessment Submission Extensions (Covid-19 enforced)

Context

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, apprenticeship students are having their studies affected in a number of ways. Students in areas of work considered essential are no longer being given time to devote to their studies. Students in areas of work that are not considered essential may no longer have access to their workplace or may have been placed on furlough. As individual circumstances vary it is requested that the challenges faced by students are managed through extensions. As the situation is ongoing, academic staff may need to give a submission date that is later than the board date. In this situation students would be taken to the next (following) monthly board.

Scope

This proposal only relates to apprenticeship students and is only to be applied during the period of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Variation

This variation to the University's regulations temporarily allows apprenticeship students to be given extensions on an individual student basis with a date for submission beyond the date of the meeting of the Board of Examiners where the module would normally be considered.
