THE N.I.D. APPROVED LIST

of Dealers in Aids to Hearing

GENERAL

The information given in this booklet is designed to be of help and guidance to deafened persons wishing to buy hearing aids.

All deafened persons contemplating the purchase of a hearing aid are advised to obtain medical advice by consulting an ear, nose and throat specialist either privately or at the ear, nose and throat department of a hospital. If deafened persons are advised to consider the purchase of an aid they should deal only with one of the manufacturers or suppliers given in this booklet. These manufacturers and suppliers have entered into an agreement with the National Institute for the Deaf as to their methods of trading. Approved firms have been issued with certificates of acceptance by the N.I.D. and these certificates will be found in the consulting rooms of all such approved firms.

THE AGREEMENT

Whilst the agreement referred to (which is available for inspection at the Institute's registered offices) contains a number of clauses which are of no direct interest to the hearing aid purchaser, it does contain some which directly concern every potential purchaser of a hearing aid. These clauses are quoted below :—

1. The Applicant(s) shall not practise or represent himself/ themselves as practising any treatment for the amelioration of deafness other than the supply of aural instruments or appliances whether mechanical or electrical.
5. Neither the Applicant(s) nor any servant or agent of the Applicant(s) shall seek to interview a client at the client's home unless at the request of the client or at the request of the client's medical adviser.
6. The Applicant(s) shall be permitted to make an optional charge not exceeding ten shillings and sixpence (10/6) for testing and consultation in cases where no otologist's report

is available and an instrument or appliance is not supplied. Where an instrument is supplied on trial no charge beyond the trial fee provided for in Clause 8 shall be made.

7. The Applicant(s) shall under no circumstances attempt to supply any instrument against the will of a client and if in the opinion of the Applicant(s) no instrument or appliance manufactured or offered for sale by him/them appears likely to ameliorate the deafness of the client the Applicant(s) shall so inform the client.

8. (a) If the purchaser of any aural instrument or appliance from the Applicant(s) shall return the same to the Applicant(s) in good order and condition within seven clear days from the date of supply thereof (or such extended period as may be arranged between the Applicant(s) and the purchaser's medical adviser) and shall request the return of the purchase price thereof, the Applicant(s) shall refund to the purchaser the whole of the said purchase price less a sum not exceeding 7½ per centum of the purchase price of such instrument or appliance.

(b) The Applicant(s) at all times shall display in a prominent position in his/her consulting rooms a specially issued certificate of approval issued by the National Institute for the Deaf and in general business literature shall issue a statement that trial is available in accordance with the National Institute for the Deaf agreement.

(c) The Applicant(s) shall not whether by advertisement or otherwise offer to purchasers or intending purchasers any terms of sale whereby they are or purport to be excluded from returning within the period mentioned in sub-clause (a) hereof aural instruments or appliances purchased from the Applicant(s) and from obtaining such refund in respect thereof as is mentioned in sub-clause (a) hereof.

9. Known and regular borrowers of aids shall be loaned instrumenta and appliances only at the Applicant(s) discretion and an approved book entry of a previous loan during the current year shall be held to be sufficient reason for the refusal of the loan of another instrument or appliances in such cases.

13. The National Institute for the Deaf shall recommend to members of the public only such vendors of aural instruments or appliances as are for the time being entered upon the Registered List of the National Institute for the Deaf.

MANUFACTURERS AND TRADE NAMES

The National Institute for the Deaf is frequently asked who are actual manufacturers of hearing aids and is often required to identify the trade name of a certain appliance with the firm which makes it. The Institute is also asked to inform enquirers as to the types of appliance available from the various firms approved by the Institute. These points are dealt with in this booklet in the two following lists.

THE LISTS

The first list shows the firms which *make* hearing aids of various kinds and they are all included in the general alphabetical list of suppliers which follows it. The number to the left of each manufacturer is used in the general list to indicate the make of appliances available and on the right of the manufacturer's name will be found the trade name of his appliance. Where manufacturers make group hearing aids this is indicated in full in the manufacturers list and by a "G" after the coding numbers in the general list. The letter "M" in the general list indicates that mechanical (*i.e.* non-electrical) hearing aids such as speaking tubes, trumpets, auricles and resonators of various kinds are available.

LIPREADING

Deafened persons are advised to consider the study of lipreading, whether they use hearing aids or not, either by private or class tuition or by home study where no other method is available.

Details of lipreading classes will be found in the N.I.D. booklet No. 482, and a list of private teachers of lip-reading is available from the Institute, free of charge.

A text-book for the home study of lipreading and to give additional help to those already receiving instruction is published by the N.I.D., "Lipreading" by J. H. Burchett, published by the National Institute for the Deaf, 105, Gower Street, London, W.C.1. Price 6/6, post free.
