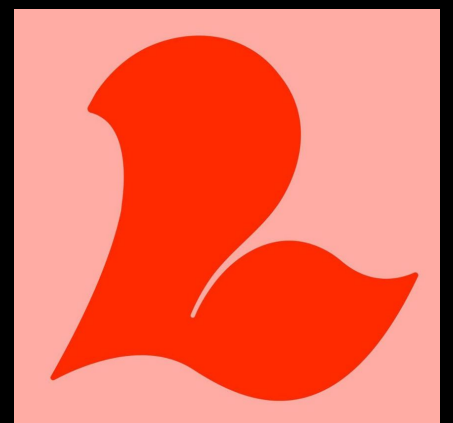
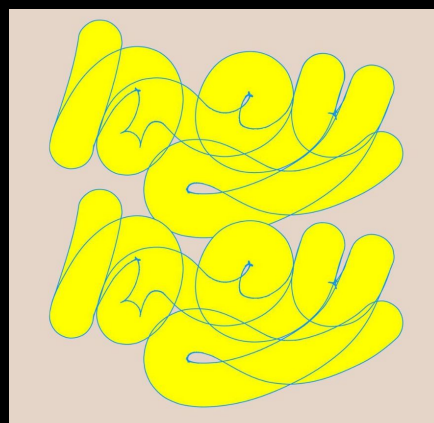
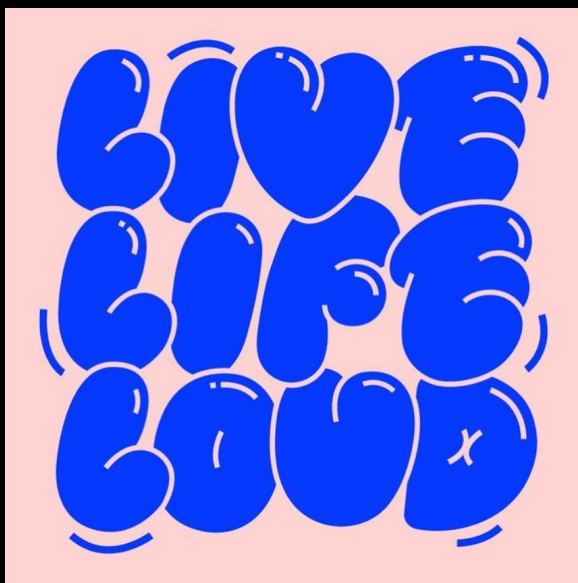
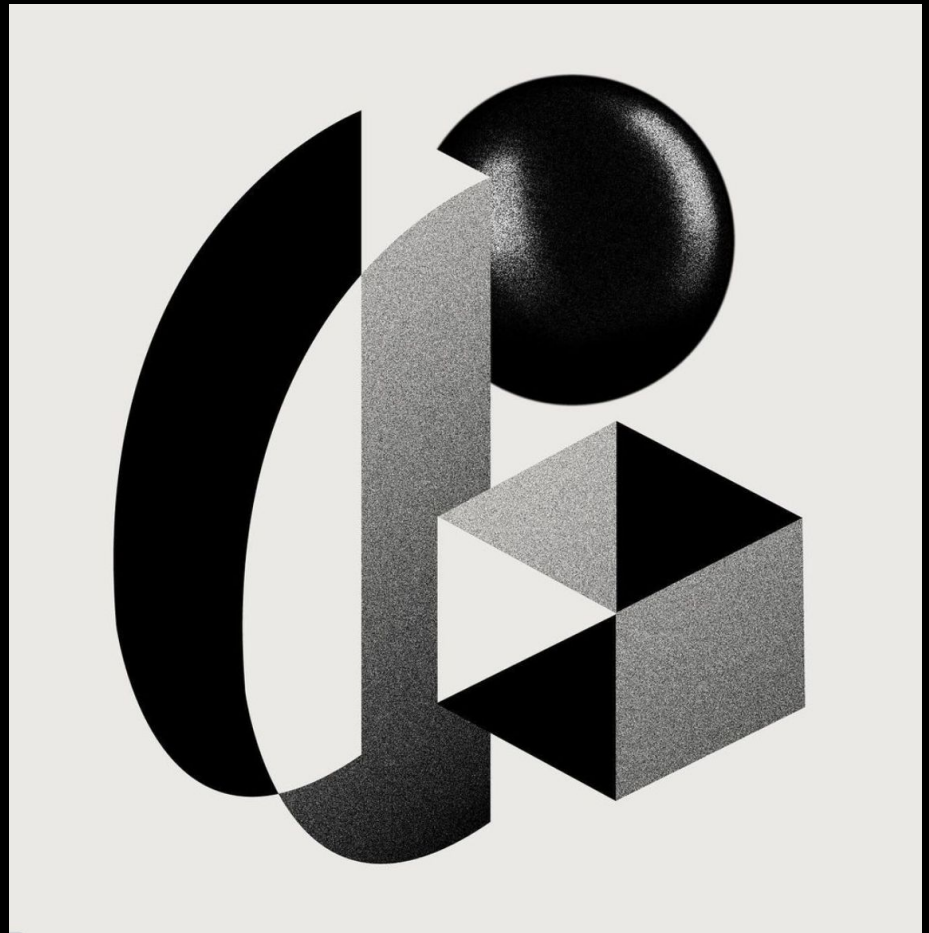
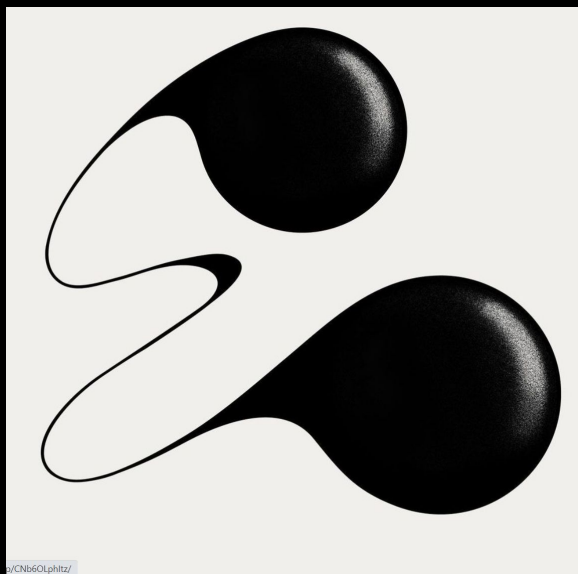


CONNOR DAVEY
