Why join a class?

It is important that you join the class associated with your course, so your lecturer can easily access and moderate your site.

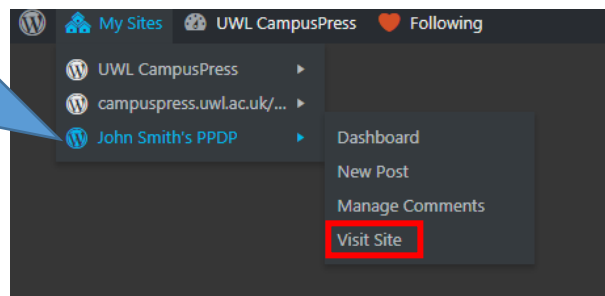
1. Locate the site you have created for assessment, **it is important** you use this site for work associated with this module.

Ensure you select the site you will be using for your work.

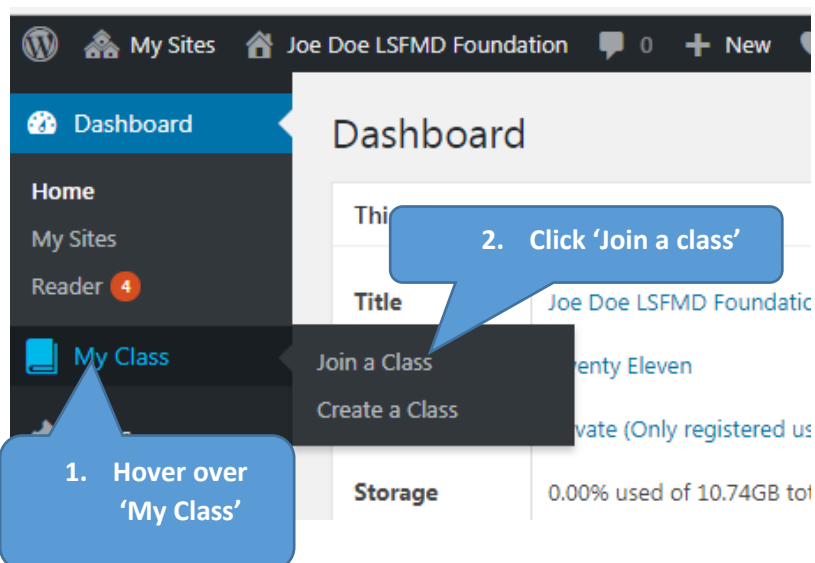
The name in this list will be whatever you chose when you set up your site.

This can be changed at any time.

The URL will be *studentnumbera* for example 12325789a, this can be checked by clicking on the site and checking the web address



2. From the correct site go to 'Dashboard' go to 'My Class' and 'Join a class'.



3. Ensure you join the class which is attached to your cohort. The name of your classblog will be provided by your lecturer.
