## Literacy

**Reading:** This term we will continue to focus on reading with fluency and expression in reading group work. We will also be looking at the language an author uses to engage the reader. In addition to this, we will look at the skill of sequencing a text.

**Writing:** We will be reinforcing the importance of punctuation in our writing but also looking at how to use descriptive language to make work more interesting. This will be done through work on character and setting.

## Numeracy

In numeracy we will continue to work on place value, addition and subtraction. We will also focus on the vocabulary used for addition and subtraction in word problems.

In maths we will investigate 2D and 3D shape.

In addition we will continue to use our skills on time, building on previous learning.

## Learning in other areas of the curriculum

**Science:** P3 will undertake a short investigation of Plants. This will include revising what plants need to grow, why plants are important and how we can protect them. We will also look at and study different types of seeds and plants and where you might find them in the world.

**Music:** The P3s will be working with our music specialist Mrs Callaghan each week. They will be learning a variety of music skills and techniques through singing songs and playing the instruments. We will also be preparing for our Christmas celebrations concert.

## Health & Wellbeing

This term we will continue to focus on our Core Values as part of our Bounce Back programme.

We will continue to have 2 sessions of PE - one with Mrs Tait and the other with the class teacher. PE days are Monday and Thursday.
