Literacy

Pupils will have the opportunity to engage with a variety of texts, identifying the main events and characters. We will continue to develop story writing through retelling stories orally and learning to spell new vocabulary. During the term we will also focus on non-fiction writing.

Numeracy

In numeracy we will continue to work on place value, addition and subtraction to 100 and beyond. We will also focus on learning multiplication and division strategies. In maths we will learn about position, movement and co-ordinates.

Learning in other areas of the curriculum

Art: This term P3 will be working with our art specialist every Wednesday afternoon.

RME: We will learn about Christian values and beliefs through reading various Bible stories. We will also learn about key beliefs in Islam.

Social Studies: Develop an understanding of the history and culture of Scotland through poetry, music and art. We will also explore the variety of foods produced in Scotland.

Health & Wellbeing

This term we will continue to focus on our Core Values as part of our Bounce Back programme.

We will continue to have 2 sessions of PE - one with Mrs Tait and the other with the class teacher. PE days are Monday and Thursday.
