## Transition to Lasswade High School

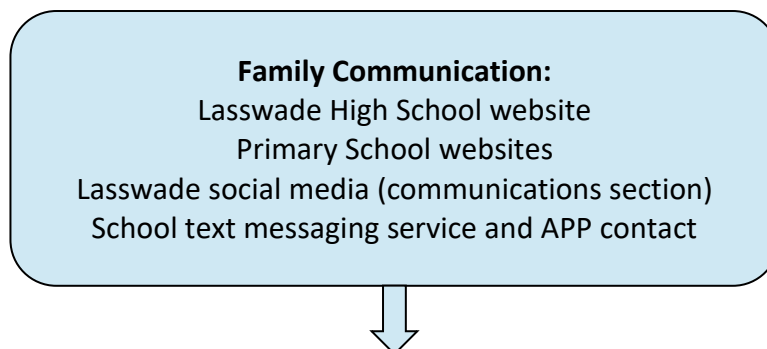
I hope you and your families are well and staying safe during these challenging and changing times. I realise that this may be a particularly unsettling time for families, especially as your child is about to transition from primary school to secondary school.

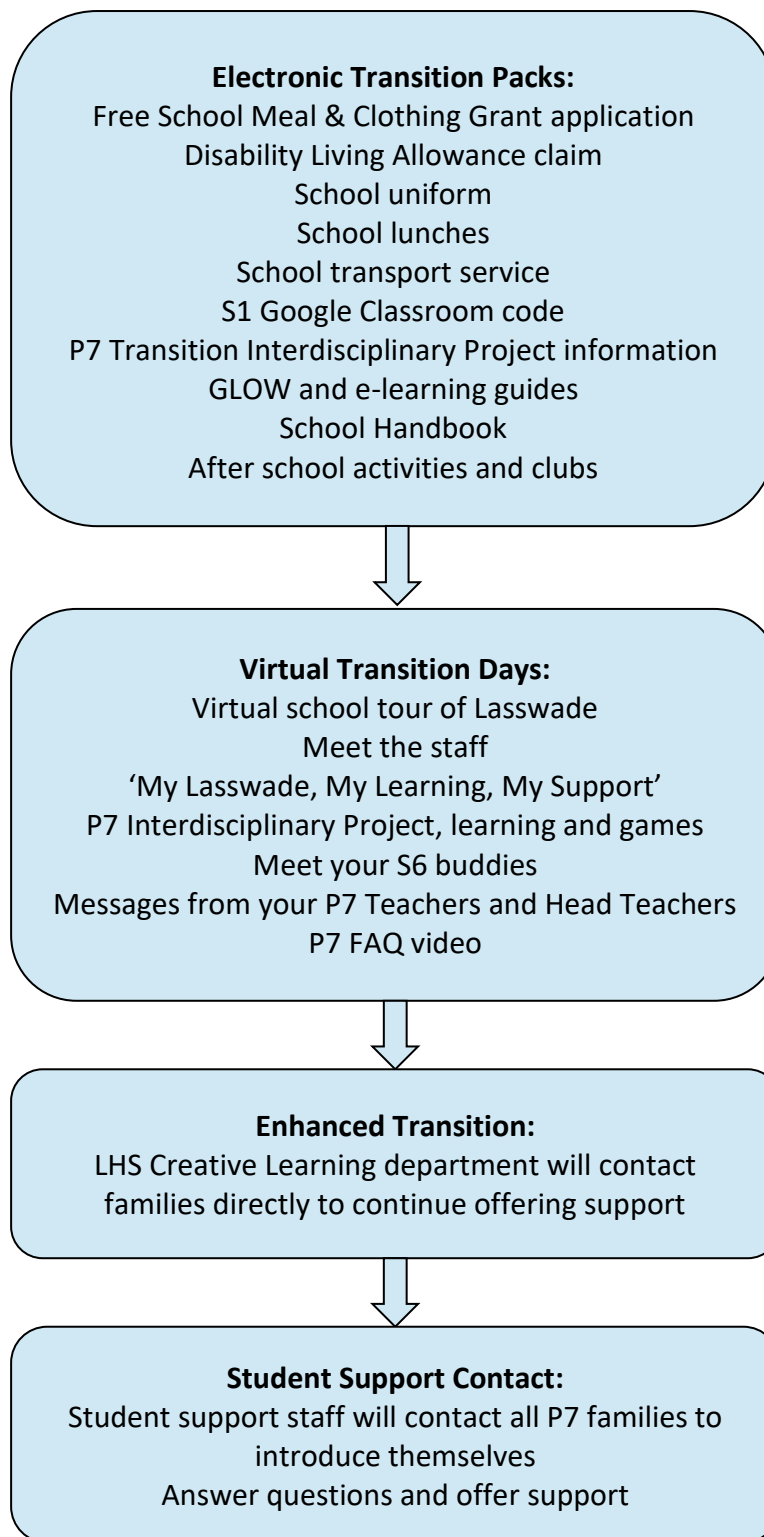
At Lasswade, we care about all of our students and families across the entire school community. Our new S1 cohort is a key priority and we have supportive and robust plans in place for P7 to S1 transition this year. We want to reassure you that we have been working closely with our associated Primary Schools, especially Head Teachers and Primary 7 Teachers, since August 2019 on transition.

At this stage, we have no indication about how and when schools will reopen. Therefore all Midlothian primary and secondary schools have agreed to deliver consistent outcomes for P7 to S1 transition, which can be found on our school website. As transition will be 'virtual', having access to a device will be important for your child.
