## 5. Head Teacher's Update

- Staffing :
  - Mrs Stewart on Maternity leave – Miss Judith Little is in place
- Lots of achievements in the school – very positive feel.
  - Good feedback from p7s at athletic – Good teamwork and sportsmanship. Good manners shown by all.
  - 70 Bronze Active Schools certificates given out (p1-p7)
  - P6s had a good assembly and Burn's supper. Good turnout from parents.
- Spanish teaching student in to work with p5-p7s in Spanish culture and language.
- Family learning centre
  - On target to open after the February Break
  - Looking at additional funding to benefit the nursery and the FLC
- Layout of the nursery is to change. By looking at good practice at outer nurseries the change was decided. This should give adults in the room high quality interaction with the children. This should be completed for returning after the February break with plans for future with to give both sides access to the toilets and a small kitchen in the second room.
