Primary 1 have had a busy start to the year. So far we have been learning about The Seasons, Toys and we have also enjoyed the experience of performing this year's Nativity - A Miracle in Town - to a live audience. We have learned lots of sounds, tricky words and have been exploring word building. We have designed our own classroom library and cannot wait for all of our things to arrive! In writing we have been learning how to give ourselves useful feedback to make our work even better, we are getting very good at this. We have actively engaged in our number and maths work. We have learned directional language, coin identification, 2D shape and days of the week.





Team Teach Afternoons

On Tuesday afternoons the children have the opportunity to work with different pupils and teachers in Primary 1. During this time we rotate between the four classes and have a different curricular area focus in each room.

Miss Ferguson has been introducing the children to French greetings, we will be moving onto colours and naming parts of the body. 

Miss Easson has been teaching different aspects of Maths. We are currently learning about symmetry and will be moving onto time. 

Miss Hutchison has been teaching different strategies for managing a range of emotions and recognising these in others. After this, she'll be moving onto friendships. 

Miss Slymand has been focusing on Global Citizenship and the U.N. Rights of the Child. This is following up from the work the children do in Citizenship Gathering with Miss Reid.
