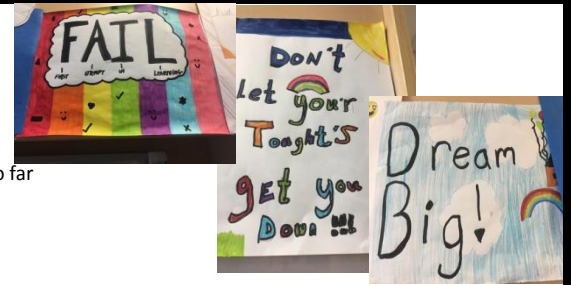


# Primary 70
