Week 1 – (Due 28.2.20)

It is a cold February night and you are snuggled up in your bed sleeping soundly. You awake to see a bright light shining in your window. You get out of your cosy bed and make your way to the window.....

- Describe the first time you see the alien – what is it like?
- The alien wants to be your friend? How do you feel
- What do you say to the friendly alien?

Write a passage describing this first meeting and draw a picture of your new friend – think about colours and detail – remember to label your drawing and tell me its name.

Success Criteria – Try to use descriptive – ADJECTIVES!!!

Week 2 – (Due 6.3.20)

Your new friend wants to learn about your life and it wants to come to school with you. You have to sneak it out of your house, past your parents and take it to school. Where will it go once you are at school – will you get it a school dinner? – on the sheet provided create a story board showing the events of the day – you can use speech bubbles and text as well as detailed cartoons to tell me what happened.

Success Criteria – Make sure that your story board sections all fit together and the reader will know what is happening.

Week 3 – (Due 13.3.20)

Your new friend does not really like school because it does not understand why you have to learn – it is especially puzzled with MATHS. You decide to teach your alien what you have learned in Maths this week.

You should think about how you are going to teach your friend but you must include

- What you are learning (fractions, time, dividing or multiplying...)
- Why you think it is important to learn it
- What you find easy and what you are looking to improve
- Make/draw a resource – poster, worksheet, demonstration

(You will probably have some writing and some drawing).

Success Criteria – What do you want to teach your alien? Make sure you remain focused and clear! – practise on someone at home!

Week 4 – (Due 20.3.20)

The alien is homesick ☹ and wants to go home! It would really like for you to go with it and see its family and home planet. How do you get there? Write about your journey – you can illustrate it if you like.....What is it like? What can you see from the rocket/space ship? What does it feel like? What does the planet look like? What is the landing like? These are a few ideas you may want to include.

Success Criteria – You want the reader to experience what you feel, so think about the way you describe things – you should also mention how you feel and why. – a short piece of writing will not be acceptable – this task requires a few paragraphs!

Week 5 – (Due 27.3.20)

You are having a fantastic time on this planet but you know you have to go home – before you go though, the aliens want to throw you a HUGE party – your first task is to make or draw an invitation to your party...you may want to include; date/time, what events/games there will be, what foods, where it will be, dress code etc? Who will be there – famous aliens?

Your second task is to help the aliens write a shopping list for everything they need for your party.

Success Criteria try to be as creative as you can – remember it is another planet so they may have different calendars, foods, words etc – remember this for the shopping list

Week 6 – (Due 6.4.20)

It is now one week since you arrived back home on planet EARTH...Write a diary entry describing how you feel, you could include what you miss about your friend, what your last day on the planet was like, how you got home, what you have done in the past week etc...

Success Criteria – This is a personal piece of writing so you will write from your point of view using “I...” – you should also begin with “Dear diary...” – a short piece of writing will not be acceptable – this task requires a few paragraphs!
