School Meals

As from Monday 19th August school meals will rise by 10p to £2.10 per day. Pupils who take school meals will be issued with 2 menus on Monday 17th June.

- 1 for week commencing 24th June

and

- 1 for the first week of the new term commencing 19th August.

Both menus should be returned by **Wednesday 19th June** in order that catering staff can make the necessary arrangements.

Lunches, for P4-7 pupils will cost £2.10 per day - £8.40 Monday - Thursday and £10.50 Monday - Friday.

Next session, P3 will continue to be entitled to a free school meal. From Mondays to Thursdays children will have the choice of a hot or cold lunch and on Fridays, a packed lunch, to be eaten at home.

Payments should be made on **Wednesday 19th June** for meals ordered for the two weeks either by cash, cheque (payable to Midlothian Council) or by ParentPay.
