In Lasswade Nursery, we aim to continually evaluate and develop our practice to ensure the highest quality learning experiences for our children at all times. Over the course of this year we will be developing the following priorities in line with the whole School Improvement Plan.

School Improvement Plan Priority

Raising attainment in literacy, specifically reading with an increase in 10% of children achieving a level by end of P1, P4 and P7



Further develop the impact of Visible Learning on all our learners from Nursery to Primary 7.



Continue to raise attainment in numeracy, using SEAL, from Nursery to P7



In Nursery we will...

Create a positive reading ethos in nursery

Introduce and monitor Big Bedtime Read in Nursery for all children

Inform and involve parents in all aspects of Big Bedtime Read Implementation

All staff will engage in professional reading and training about Making Learning Visible in Nursery

Planning will be visible in nursery
Parents, children and staff will input in planning
Planning will be child friendly with photographs, pictures and children's comments displayed around nursery at children's eye level

Staff will talk to children about their learning:

- Where they are in their learning
- How they are learning
- What they can do to get better in their learning

All staff will engage in training of SEAL (Stages of Early Arithmetical Learning)

SEAL learning activities will be central to daily routines and group time activities within Nursery
