


Lasswade Nursery Evaluation Feedback



In June 2017, we issued an evaluation to all parents/carers in our nursery. This evaluation was to provide us with invaluable feedback about the care and learning we provide in our setting. We have used this evaluation to provide next steps in our nursery practice to ensure we are creating the best possible learning experiences for all our pupils. The feedback given is detailed below.

Our Next Steps



Communication

Many parents would like more frequent communication.



We aim to update the notice board weekly to ensure parents are aware of upcoming events the week before they are due to take place.

We aim to ensure an equal balance of morning and afternoon nursery children's learning is evident on our Twitter page @lasswadeps.

All correspondence will be placed in children's pigeon holes to ensure children who are part time receive the same information as those who attend nursery full time.

Sharing of Children's Learning with Parents

Some parents would like more information about where how their child is progressing in their learning.



We will continue to have shared learning sessions, stay and play and parental consultations for parents/carers at intervals throughout the year.

Learning books will be present in nursery at all times with open access for both children and parents/carers.

Other Areas to Improve

Some parents feel the nursery entrance/exit door is very crowded at drop off and pick up.

One parent would like water to be available to all children throughout the Nursery session.



Our Nursery entrance will no longer be shared with our Primary 1 children which will reduce the volume of people through the door. We will monitor how well the Nursery traffic flows and adapt the drop off and pick up routine if necessary.

We will continue to ensure water is available for all Nursery children at all times. Water is currently available on the snack table throughout a Nursery session.
