Literacy

- Read your reading book
- Share a story
- Practise your sounds (play the sound games)
- Practise your handwriting
- Write sounds, words, a story
- Play I-spy / go on a sound hunt around your house

Numeracy & Maths

- Count forwards and backwards as far as you can
- Count how many forks, knives and spoons you have in the cutlery drawer. How many do you have altogether?
- Play a board game using dice
- If it snows, build a snowman. Measure him. How tall is he? Can you measure him using your hands, boxes, other objects? Can you measure him using string or a measuring tape? Who is taller? You, your snowman or your adult?
- Play on Sumdog

Topic

- Watch a weather forecast and identify the different symbols
- Be your own forecaster
