



## Severe Weather Learning – Primary 2

If the school is closed due to severe weather, you can keep up to date with your learning using any of the following activities.

**Reading**– each reading group will most likely have a book they can continue reading. If it is finished, you can write a book review or draw a picture of the characters.

Take the reading challenge. It is in your reading folder.

**Spelling** – Home Learning jotters have all the words and patterns we have been practising this year. Even if we are due a new list of words, you could revise old patterns.

**Sumdog** – practise your mental maths skills on Sumdog. Our passwords are in our Reading Diaries. Remember to be accurate as well as speedy.

**Maths** – practise number bonds, number patterns, forwards and backwards counting, making arrays, counting in groups, dividing into groups, work on tens and ones. You can also revise your shape and time knowledge. Read different times on analogue and digital clocks. Work out durations. Make a poster to show your learning.

**Writing** – write an imaginative story. Let your imagination go wild! Don't forget to check your work for correct punctuation.
