

# What is the BiteSite?



Newbattle HS runs a cafeteria-style service, known as the 'BiteSite', which operates in the morning, at break and during lunch.

We are really excited that the BiteSite will be reopening on **29<sup>th</sup> November**.



*On the first week of reopening, we will only be providing a lunch service then resuming to breakfast, break and lunch from w/c 6<sup>th</sup> December.*

# How do I upload money?

A cashless catering system is used in the BiteSite, so any funds must be pre-loaded onto pupils lunch PINs/Card as no cash will be accepted at the till.

You can load money onto your child's pin via [ParentPay](#), or by giving them cash to load manually in the BiteSite (pic B). The money goes onto the card within minutes.

Pupils can either pay for their lunch by scanning their Young Scot Card (pic A), or by entering their PIN at the till.

A pupil 'meal deal' lunch costs £2.30.

S1/2 Pupils will receive a copy of their unique pin number in homeroom on the week of 22<sup>nd</sup> November.

Pupils on FSM's will also be able to either enter their PIN at the till, or scan their Young Scot Card. They will have £2.30 loaded onto their card daily. If this isn't used, it doesn't get carried over.
