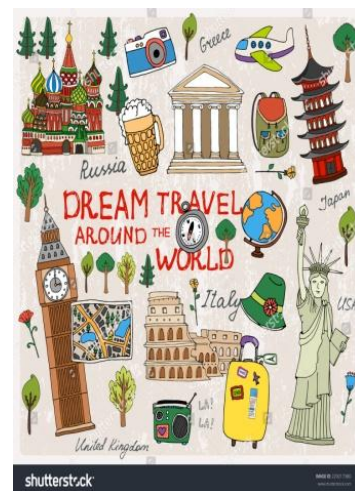

2. Why it was built.
3. The height of the landmark
4. How old it is.
5. Who designed/built it.
6. Whether or not it was a gift from another country.
7. How many people visit it each year.
8. As many other interesting facts that you can find about it.
