### **Previous Actions**

### **Coursing Process**

Julie Bones gave an overview of the coursing process:

Senior phase (S4/5/6) process was reviewed in 2016/2017 to offer a more varied curriculum to include

- More vocational opportunities
- Senior years were timetabled together
- Clearer progression
- 'Stage not age'
- Space for personal achievement and skills development
- Additional academic options e.g. YASS
- Opportunities through partnerships e.g. colleges

Last year the Broad General Education (BGE) years (S1/2/3) curriculum was reviewed, particularly 3<sup>rd</sup> year – subjects were grouped into curriculum areas, including more vocational based options, while still getting the required breadth for BGE.

A varied curriculum is one of DHS strengths – other Midlothian schools do not always offer the same choice.

There will be a combined coursing evening and curriculum evening in DHS on 7<sup>th</sup> February, letters have been sent out.

### **Head Teacher update**

#### School Review

A school review (by Midlothian Council) took place over 13-16 November 2017, and was run as if it was a school inspection. The results were very good and here are a few highlights:

- Learning, teaching and assessment – Good
- Ensuring well-being, equality and inclusion – Good
- Raising attainment and achievement – Good
- Current pathways – Strong
- Partnerships with parents/carers – Strong

Some comments:

- Positive relationships
- Good pupil engagement
- Visible learning intentions and success criteria
- Feedback used well
- School has a calm atmosphere
- Good inclusion in learning despite some having learning barriers
- Good extra curricula activities e.g. school show
- Attainment good and getting better
- All backgrounds achieving
- Many opportunities for wider achievement
- Strong house identity
- Very clear pathways and many vocational learning opportunities
- Senior phase better meets needs of learners

- Improved enjoyment of learners
- Website is considered to be one of the best
- Supportive Parent Council and PTA
- Good communication with parents/carers

### School Inspection

### **AOCB**

Marianne raised a question about pupil access to toilets during class time. The main toilets are open all day; other toilets around the school are not generally open during the day. If pupils need to go to the toilet during class time, they should ask their teacher for a toilet pass, and use the main toilets.

Alison Binns asked a question about the possibility of the school having a bank account to facilitate the direct payment of fees for school trips etc. AD confirmed this is in the pipeline but requires the go-ahead from the council.

There was a discussion around the use of messaging apps for communication. Some council members have seen how the app School Pidgeon works with other schools and have been quite impressed. AD advised that this app was not being considered at the moment, but she was looking into some homework apps with can include messaging e.g. Show My Homework and Toot Toot (for pupils but can send a message to the guidance teacher). All apps have to be considered by the council regarding any data protection issues.
