Literacy- Using the "Speed Sounds" flashcards, please practise the sounds we have learned over the last few weeks:

m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, sh, r, j, v, y, w, th, z, ch, qu, x, ng, nk

Mild Option:

- Ask your child to tell you the sounds using the flashcards included (envelope marked 'speed sounds')

Medium Option:

- Please ask your child to tell you as many words as possible that begin with the sounds learned.

Hot Option:

- Using your 'speed sound' flash cards begin to put sounds together to make simple 3 letter words. E.g. Say the word 'tap' slowly and count the sound you can hear t-a-p. Put these sounds together to say the word 'tap'. Repeat for different words.

Common Words are tricky sounds that cannot be sounded out. Please learn the following common words. We should be able to read these common words on our own! Use flashcards to help you memorise them.

- **I the you your said was are of want**

Numeracy- suggested activities

Mild Option:

- Ask your child to identify numerals from 10-20/30
- Ask for number before/after 0-20/30

Medium Option:

- Ask for number between two teen numbers 10-20/30 e.g. the number between 14 and 16

Hop Option:

- Compare two numbers which number is the largest or the smallest
