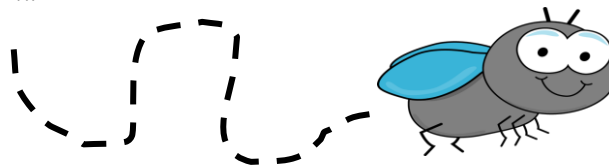
Acrostic Poem
