(if you feel able you work with numbers up to 50) Use counters/pennies/lego bricks etc to help.</p> <p>Use Education City addition and subtraction. (You will need either early **, Early ***, or First *) Begin with the easier levels until you know what level is best for your child) Log onto Education City, Click Subjects, Numeracy/activities then scroll down for addition and subtraction.</p> <p>Play Live, also in Numeracy section is excellent.
