


<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy Reading</b></p> <div style="text-align: right; border: 1px solid black; width: 40px; height: 40px; margin-left: auto;"></div> <p>Reading is very important and hopefully something that you enjoy. Read aloud with a grown up or older brother or sister at least 3 times each week. Make a list of the books or stories that you read. They can be chapter books or short stories. It's up to you!</p> <p><b>Draw a picture of something that happens in your favourite book/story or design a new cover for it.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy</b></p> <div style="text-align: right; border: 1px solid black; width: 40px; height: 40px; margin-left: auto;"></div> <p><b>Writing</b> Write a short story or make a book for a younger child. (Someone who is not yet at school and is only just beginning to learn to read.)</p> <p>You could;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Retell a story that you already know.</li> <li>• Make a counting book, teaching them to count to 10</li> <li>• Create your own short story.</li> </ul> <p>Remember - it should be colourful and quite simple. Not too many words on a page.</p> <p><i>Your teacher will be happy to give you any paper that you need.</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Numeracy / Maths</b></p> <p><b>Improve your skills in counting in 2s, 5s and 10s</b></p> <p>Choose a starting number and count in 2s, 5s or 10s from that number. Do some forwards and some backwards. You can also practice sequencing numbers.
