Literacy

Reading

Set 1 pupils will continue to blend and identify sounds within words. Set 2 children are identifying sounds within short stories and completing activities to help them identify and understand these sounds.

Writing

P2 will be continuing to focus on including capital letters, finger spaces and full stops whenever they write. We will be accompanying a detailed picture with their own words explaining what is happening and to whom. We will also make a start on functional writing with instructions for debalming a mummy!

Listening and Talking

P2 will continue to develop listening skills through sharing weekend news and class discussions during Health and Wellbeing lessons. We are learning to take turns and show respect to others. We will also focus on listening skills as part of our music lessons.

Health and Wellbeing

HWB

This term, we will be looking at understanding emotions. We will include drama and art to express various emotions, as well as our daily Zones of Regulation check ins. We will discuss what respect and kindness means and how to show it. We are developing a new "Class Charter" underpinned by our school rules.

P.E

We will continue to develop our balance and coordination skills through dance and yoga centred lessons. We will also practice relay races and exploring different movements such as hopping, skipping, bouncing and sprinting. As well as this, we will be practicing ball skills such as chest passes, dribbling and controlled passing.

Numeracy and Maths

Numeracy

We will continue to work on number bonds to 20, numbers to 100 and multiplication, focusing on the 2 times table for now. Some groups will also be working on number sequences and counting on and back, while others will work counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Maths

Our maths focus this term is time. You can practice this at home by asking your child to identify when it is half past, o'clock, quarter past and quarter to.

Other Curricular Areas

Topic

We will be learning all about the Egyptians in our topic this term, focusing on tombs, mummies, pyramids, the River Nile and significant people.

French
