Reading

Set 1 Sounds - revise the following:

m,a,s,d,t,i,n,p,g,o,c,k,u,b,f. Try reading words with these letters, reading the sounds first then blending.

Ditty - Read words using all the set 1 sounds (the whole alphabet and th, ch, ng, nk). Sound out each letter then say the word.

Set 2 sounds Practice reading aloud for fluency and expression. Use any fiction or non fiction book that takes your child's interest. Even comics such as children's National Geographic or the Beano is still using their reading skills.

Writing

Practice writing First name and Second name.

Mild - Try writing sentences with a capital letter, finger spaces, writing letters on the line and full stops. Check that your writing makes sense.

Spicy - same as mild but add an extra bit to sentence using **and**, **but**, **because** to join the sentence.

Hot - All of the above and try to use description to describe nouns. i.e The black furry cat with sharp claws. Or think about opening your sentence with a ing ,ed or ly word i.e. Laughing the slimy scaly dragon bared his pointy dripping teeth.
