Literacy

Reading -

AR - We will be continuing with our Accelerated Reading programme where pupils have access to a selection of books.

Class Novel - Throughout our topic of Magic, Myths and Mystery, Primary 6 will be reading extracts from a range of books that will assist our understanding of the world of witchcraft and wizardry.

Writing -

Report Writing

We will be continuing writing news reports. Aiming to explore different subjects and increasing our use of facts and opinion throughout the reports.

We will also be introducing science reports throughout our Magic, Myths and Mystery topic.

Letter Writing

Identifying key features included within a letter, writing and responding to letters.

Listening and Talking -

Note taking - improving our ability to take notes using sub-headings.

Presentations skills - projection of voice, eye contact, engagement with audience and responding to feedback.

Positive Relationships - As a class we will be focusing on our school value of "Be Kind". This will involve working together to develop a classroom where we focus on positive actions towards ourselves and one another.

Numeracy and Maths

Numeracy-

Primary 6 will be learning about fractions, percentages and decimals.

We will be continuing to work on our knowledge of multiplication and division.

Maths -

Measurement - using various measuring devices, converting between units of measure- for example metres to kilometres and calculating perimeter and volume.

Time - developing our knowledge of 12- and 24-hour time. Using a variety of methods to measure time and calculating durations.

Topic

Science - Magic, Myths and Mystery.

Primary 6 have received an invitation to the Mythical Manor School of Witchcraft and Wizardry where they will explore a variety of scientific concepts.
