<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy Reading</p> <p>We have now finished learning all of our set 1 sounds in class. Can you practice reading and pronouncing your sounds correctly?</p> <p>Listen to /Read a story with an adult at home; discuss what happened in the story and what your favourite part was.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy Writing</p> <p>Can you practice writing your speech sounds using the rhymes/stories we use in the classroom to help you?</p> <p>Challenge - You may try to sound out simple words like cat, dog, hut, pin, lip and write these in your home learning jotter or type them on a computer or Ipad.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy / Maths</p> <p>Can you practice drawing a square, triangle, rectangle and circle. Discuss how many sides and corners the shapes have.</p> <p>Practice counting forwards and backwards from different numbers. Circles - numbers to 30 Triangles - numbers to 15/20 Squares - numbers to 10</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">HWB</p> <p>We have been learning about Positive Relationships and being kind to others.</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of a time when you were kind and ask an adult to write a short sentence to go with it. What did you do and how did this make you feel? You can share this with us on the Google classroom if you wish.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learning Across the Curriculum</p> <p>P1 are learning all about 'Under the Sea'.</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of an animal that lives under the sea and think about what their habitat would look like. Think of the water, seaweed, rocks and stones. Can you have a discussion about this animal with a grown up and share your picture on the Google classroom and/or twitter.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Learning Across the Curriculum</p> <p>Log onto Education City Homework and try the Science task. Using your understanding of Floating and Sinking can you find objects in the house that you can test to see if they will float or sink. Ask an adult to write down or discuss what you think will happen. If you would like to upload pictures of your experiments this would be great!</p>
