

CHILDREN'S HALLOWEEN DISCOS – VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED

The Fundraising Group are proposing to organise the first key fundraiser of the new term which is the Halloween Discos for the children on Wednesday 1st November. However, before organisation goes any further, we need to make sure we will have the correct number of Parent Helpers at each disco. The discos we propose are:

Wednesday 1st November 2017

P1-P3 – 4.00-5.00 pm

P4-P7 – 5.30-6.30 pm

We would ask that Parent Helpers arrive 15 minutes before the start of the disco.

A special note to P1 parents. If your child is attending the disco an adult is required to stay on the premises for the duration. We find that the wee ones prefer to have the reassurance of a parent nearby for their first event! If you don't have any other children with you, it would be great if you could volunteer to help out.
