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Dear Parents and Carers

Dalguise Residential Camp – 30th October – 2nd November 2018

I am sure the children are looking forward to the trip to Dalguise Centre. Below are some reminders which we hope you will find helpful. We look forward to a very successful trip.

STAFFING: The children will be accompanied by Miss Louise Ferguson, Mrs Amy Thomson, Miss Claire Henderson, Miss Laura Fraser, Mrs Jennifer Mclean and Miss Rachel Kennedy.

BEHAVIOUR: To make this trip a success we need children to co-operate by showing respect to others and following instructions. **Please spend time with your child reinforcing this message.**

DEPARTURE: 9.30am – children should arrive in school by **9.00am**. Luggage should be left in the middle atrium. The dinner hall can be used as a waiting area.

EQUIPMENT: Please remember that the children need old clothes that you won't mind getting wet and dirty; important items are – a waterproof jacket, walking boots if you have them, PLEASE REMEMBER HAT AND GLOVES, BUT NO JEANS FOR WALKING. A kit list is attached. The food is excellent and children **MUST NOT** pack extra sweets.

CHILDREN MUST NOT BRING A MOBILE TELEPHONE – THERE IS NOT TELEPHONE RECEPTION

THE JOURNEY: IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT CHILDREN HAVE WITH THEM A SMALL BAG CONTAINING A WATER BOTTLE AND A PACKED LUNCH. This should go as hand luggage on the coach. All other luggage should be in **ONE** large holdall or suitcase, to go in the boot of the coach, that children can carry easily themselves.



MEDICINES: It is possible that we may need to administer medicines, including Paracetamol, Calpol or Travel Sickness Tablets, you should have already completed the green consent form – without this we cannot administer anything. IF THERE IS ANY CHANCE THAT YOUR CHILD WILL SUFFER FROM TRAVEL SICKNESS, PLEASE GIVE THEM A TRAVEL SICKNESS PILL PRIOR TO COMING TO SCHOOL ON THE MONDAY MORNING. It is also important that they are given sufficient tablets for the journey home. All other medications should be labelled clearly with your child's name and the dosage instructions, put into a clear plastic bag along with the MED1 or MED2 form and given to your child's teacher.

RETURN: Return time should be approximately 12 noon on Friday 2nd November. We will send you a text in the morning with a more accurate time.
