Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be exploring safety. We will be learning about safety in the home, around others and also in relation to fireworks! Primary 2 will also be learning about people who can help us.

Topic

This term we will be learning about the 1960s. We will investigate the differences between then and now. Primary 2 will learn about clothing, toys, art, music and lots of other things related to the 1960s!

We will cover topics such as Halloween, Guy Fawkes and Christmas. This will include lots of fun arts and crafts activities that we hope Primary 2 will enjoy!

Literacy

We will continue to develop our understanding of individual sounds and digraphs. We will soon be handing home reading books. We will be handing them out on a Monday, but will be asking that they are returned on a Thursday. When reading we will try to develop our fluency and expression. In writing we will be continuing to cover a range of genres. This will include acrostic poems, letters and instructions. The Primary 2 children will begin to self-assess their work against our writing toolkit. This will allow them to identify their next steps.

Numeracy and Maths -

This term, we will continue to focus on information and data handling. In class we will be learning about different strategies to help us add, subtract, multiply and divide. We will learn mental strategies, but also use concrete materials such as 100 squares.
